## The Gospel Overcomes Paganism ILLUSTRATED SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

Scripture—Acts 18:23—21:16; Ephesians 5:15-18.

In Ephesus Paul spoke boldly in the synagogue. When some of his hearers hardened their hearts and would not believe, he taught in a school for two years, "so that all Asia heard the word, both Jews and Greeks."

So potent was Paul's preaching that many believed, and some of those who practiced "curious arts," brought their magic books and burned them before all people. "So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed."

Demetrius, a silversmith who made silver shrines for the temple of Diana, complained to his workmen that Paul's teaching was ruining their business and turning many away from the goddess worship. His listeners were very angry.

Going to Jerusalem Paul stayed seven days in Tyre. Whole families went to see him sail, weeping because he said they probably would never see his face again.
