On the stormy voyage to Rome, the 276 persons aboard the ship feared they would be lost. Paul told them he had a message from God that all would be safe, and advised them to eat. Shipwrecked but safe, the crew and prisoners landed on the island of Melita where the natives treated them with kindness. The father of the island's chief was ill, and Paul healed him. Arrived at Rome at last, but in chains, the brethren there, hearing of Paul's coming, flocked to meet him and his companions. When Paul saw them he gave thanks to God and took courage.
