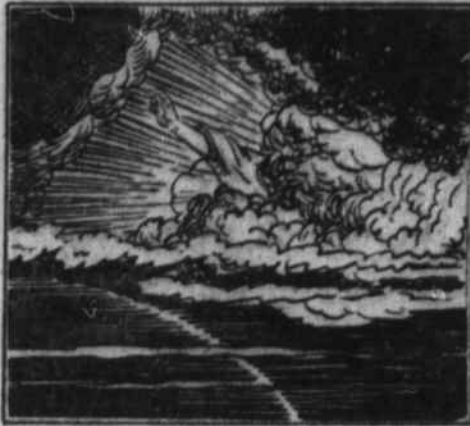

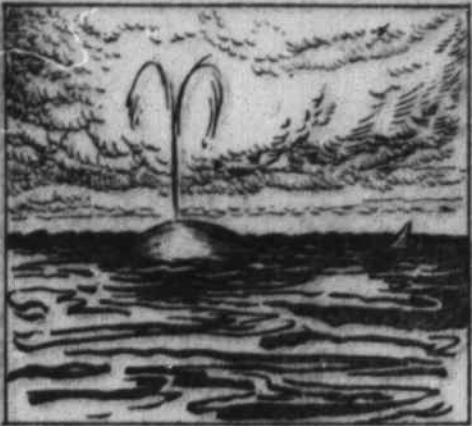
## Great Passages of the Bible ILLUSTRATED SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

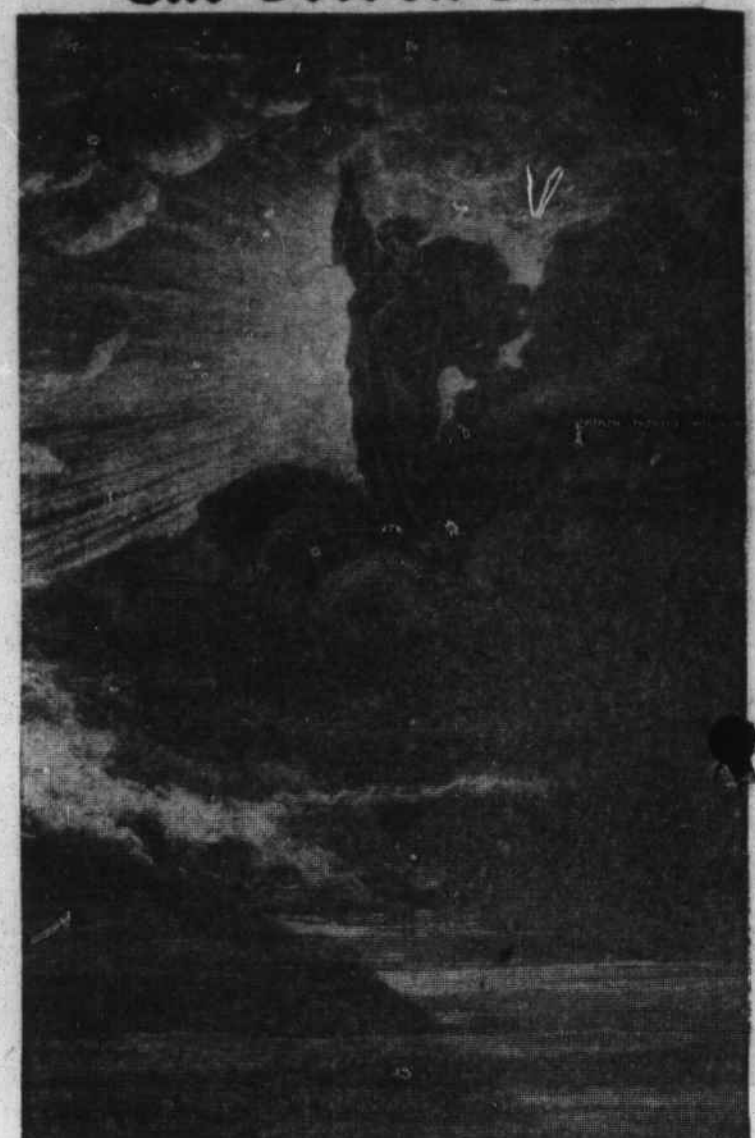
