**Midget Gridders Meet Asheville At WTHS Tonight**

The Midget Mountaineer football team will play their third game of the season at 7 p.m. tonight at the WTHS stadium, meeting the Asheville YMCA squad.

In their last start, the midget gridders were shut out by the Canton Gra-Y Bears, 27-0.

Admission for tonight's game is 50 cents for adults and 25 cents for students. Proceeds are used to buy uniforms and equipment for the midget team, coached by Rock Powers, Rufus Pannell, and Scratch Inman.

## Clyde Wins 7th Straight By Halting Old Fort, 24-0

The undefeated Clyde Cardinals gained their seventh straight Skyline-A Conference victory Friday afternoon by shutting out Old Fort, 24-0, on the loser's field.

The win marked the fifth time that the Maroon and Gold gridders have held a conference opponent scoreless.

Clyde scored three quick touchdowns in the first quarter and then coasted for two periods before tallying their final touchdown in the fourth quarter.

In the early moments of the game, Clyde mounted a long drive that ended with Danny Caldwell plunging over from the one. Midway in the quarter, Dean Haynes scored from two yards out, and end Ray Seav added a third touchdown by taking a 45-yard pass from quarterback Bob McCracken.

Fullback Johnny Rogers blasted through the Old Fort line for six yards and Clyde's final touchdown in the fourth quarter.

The Cardinals predominated on the ground, finishing ahead 18 to 11 in first downs, and 227 to 136 in yards rushing, but Old Fort had an edge in passing yardage — 78 to 56.

Next game for Clyde will be Friday afternoon at Tryon.

## Outstanding Football For Haywood Fans This Week

Two of the top Blue Ridge Conference grid games of the 1956 season will be played on Haywood sod this week when Brevard invades Waynesville Thursday night, and Hendersonville visits Canton Friday night.

The clash at Canton Memorial Stadium between the two Blue Ridge powerhouses probably could be termed the outstanding high school football game in Western North Carolina this year since the winner will almost certainly be crowned conference champion.

Although both Brevard and Waynesville have dropped two conference tilts and are virtually out of the loop race, a game between the two strong rivals always generates a lot of excitement.

The Brevard-Waynesville game was originally set here Friday night, but was moved up one night to permit local fans to see Canton and Hendersonville play Friday.

Single reserve seats will be sold for this game Thursday night, if it has been announced.

In the Paper City, the unbeaten Canton High Black Bears (6-0) will go against the defending conference champion Hendersonville Bearcats, who have been beaten only in a non-conference game at Greenville, S. C.

Haywood County's other two pigskin squads will be both on foreign soil this week, with Clyde journeying to Tryon Friday afternoon, and Bethel visiting Christ School at Arden Saturday afternoon.

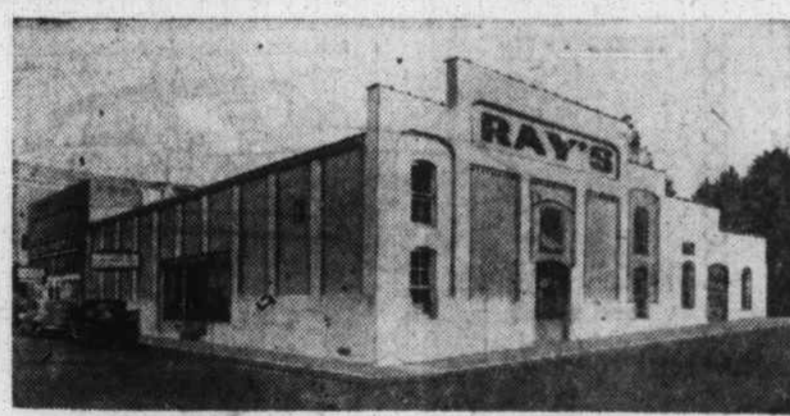
