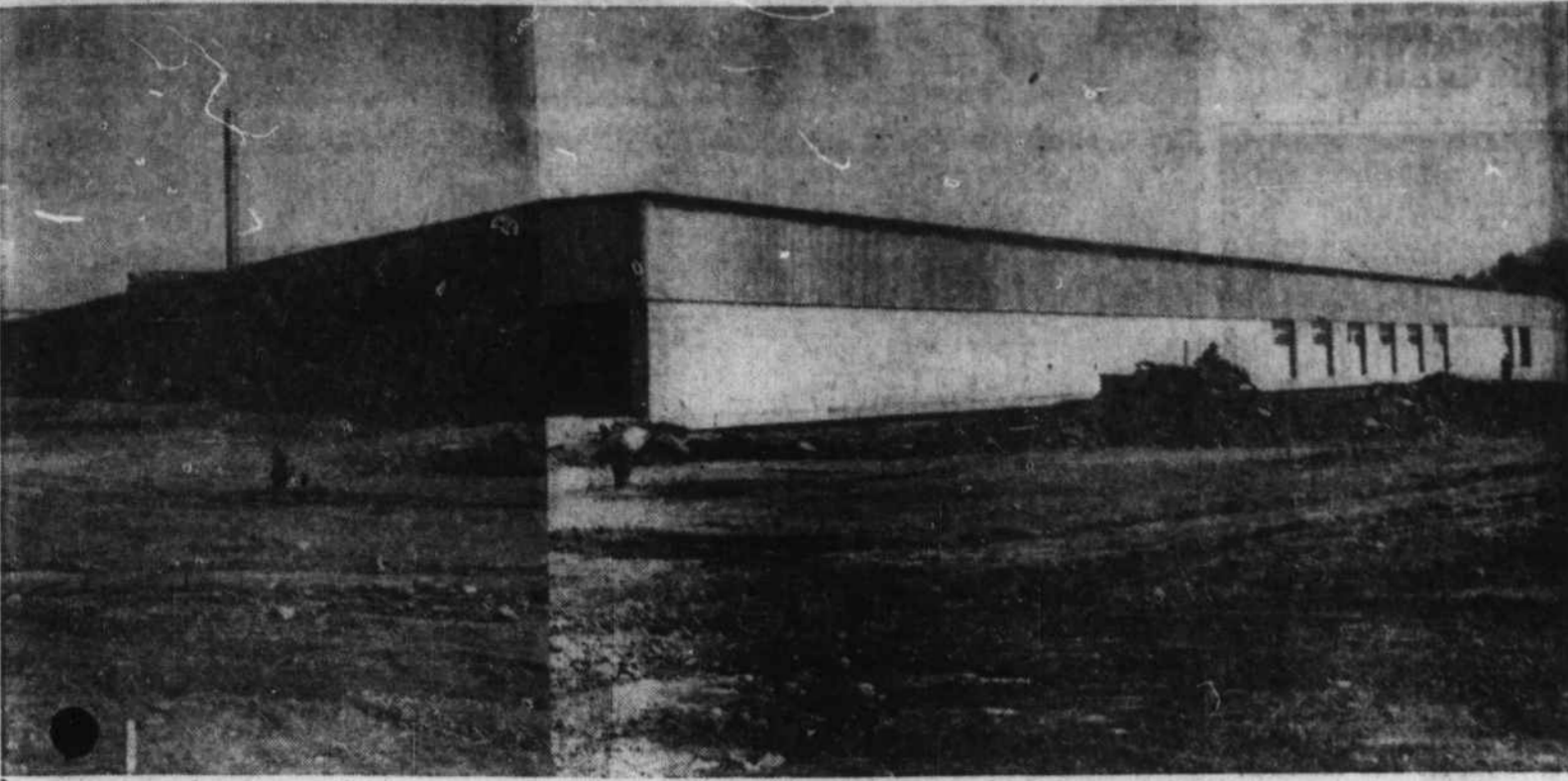


New Unagusta Plant Will Be Among The Finest In Entire Country

New Lines Of Furniture To Be Made

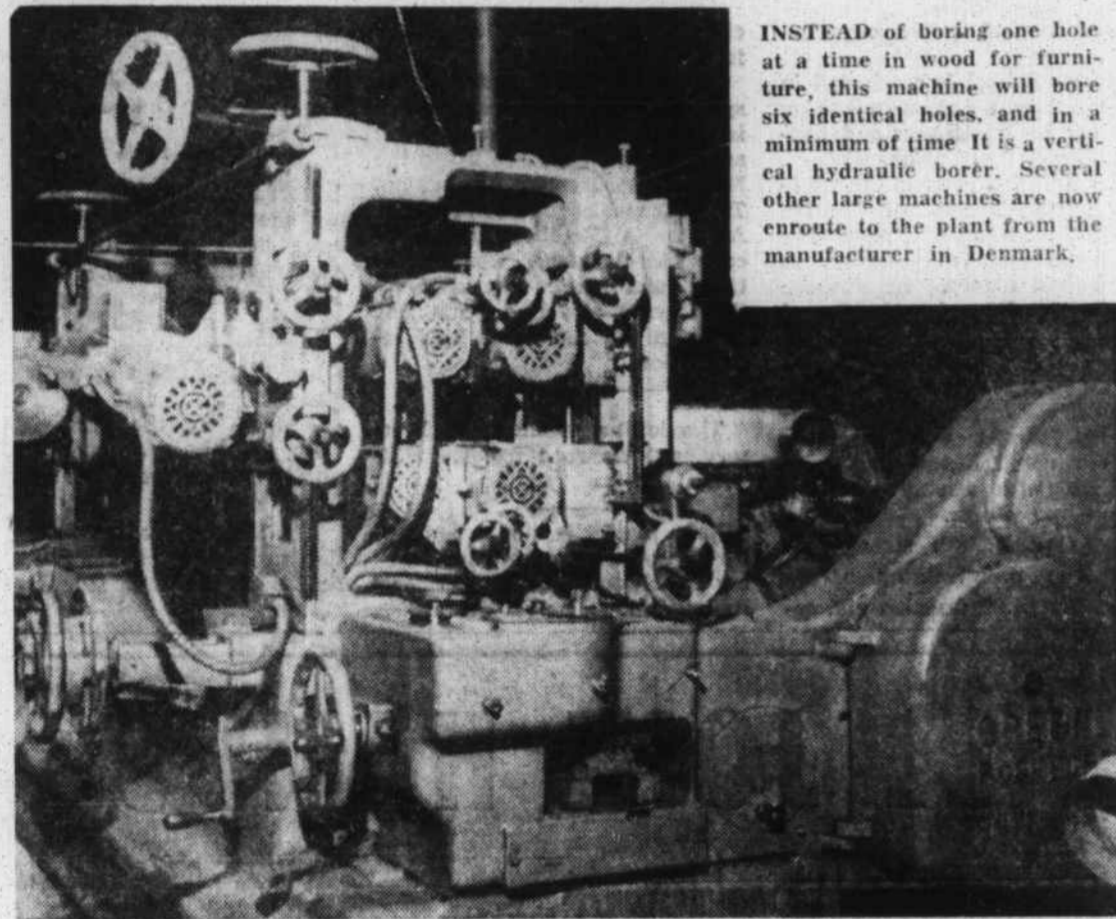
A holocaust less than a year ago was the spark that set off a huge building and modernization program for one of Hazelwood's oldest industries. Burned to the ground last November, the No. 2 plant of Unagusta Manufacturing Corporation is scheduled to reopen in little over a month.

The new building's 200,000 square feet will house the equipment necessary to turn rough lumber into bedroom and dining room furniture which will be shipped all over the United States, to Canada or to Central America.

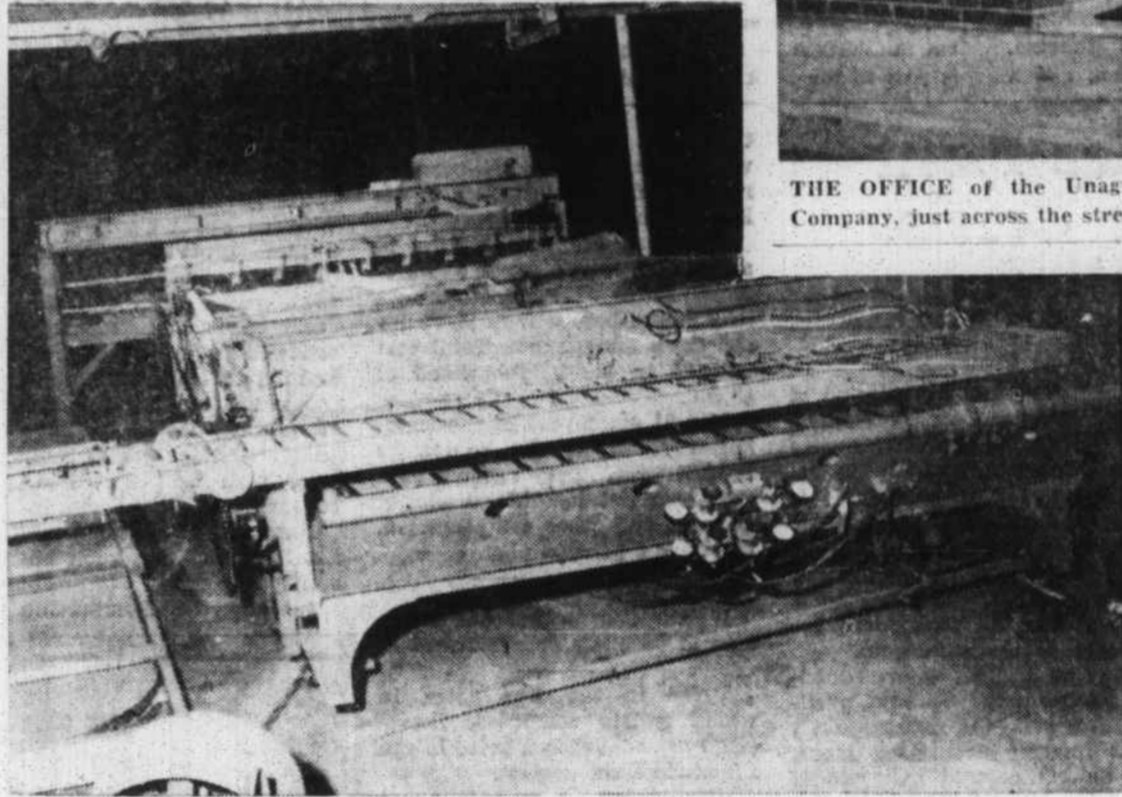
Many-tonned machinery, air conditioning units, dust collectors, a 1200-horsepower boiler and a sprinkler system including a 250,000-gallon storage tank are

INSTEAD of boring one hole at a time in wood for furniture, this machine will bore six identical holes, and in a minimum of time. It is a vertical hydraulic borer. Several other large machines are now enroute to the plant from the manufacturer in Denmark.



THIS IS the gigantic edge gluer machine just received at Unagusta Manufacturing Company. The machine is so large that a 60-foot flat car was necessary to bring it here. The machine weighs about 40,000 pounds. It is the largest made, and is heated by steam.

Shortly after the new plant goes into operation, about January, executives expect to re-employ their usual force, numbering 350 or more. The force was cut to 200 after the fire.

Unagusta employees stay with the firm, with the annual labor turnover less than 1 per cent. Ninety per cent of the employees have been with the company for six years or more; and 25 persons have been there for more than 25 years.

Hospitalization, life insurance and a retirement plan are paid for entirely by the company, with employees supplementing their own hospitalization if they desire. For the past 15 years the plant has been unionized; and it has recently signed a five-year contract.

Medical Assembly Meets In Hazelwood

Hazelwood was the headquarters this June for the 3rd annual Mountaintop Medical Assembly, and present plans are to repeat the event here next year.

Five states were represented by 77 physicians, most of them accompanied by their families.
