BY HEALTH OFFICER

There has been two cases of diphtheria, one white and one colored in Kenansville Township during the month of October, but no signs of an epidemic of this disease. One case of typhoid fever, one case of whooping cough and two cases of chickenpox have been reported for the entire county.

There appears to be a few cases of a mild influenza in nearly all parts of the county, but a severe form of influenza and pneumonia in the section west of Rose Hill.

In this section the disease is almost wholly confined to children with approximately 20 or 30 cases of pneumonia with 3 deaths, (no more deaths are expected among those having already contracted the disease.)

The temporary closing of the Rose Hill High School with other preventive measures appears to have the influenza-pneumonia situation under control for said section.

Influenza may be defined as an acute infectious highly contagious disease, characterized by a sudden onset accompanied by pains in the eyes, ears, head or back, dizziness, chilly sensation, congested eyes, temperature, and may have symptoms of a cold such as nasal discharge and some cough—the patient feels very sick.
