Railroads Spend in 88 Count in State; Communities


The railroads in 1937 bought cial war materials and supplies or fuel in school 345 cities and towns located in runnin 88 of the 100 counties of North Carolina. This fact and the nation wide spread of railway purchases was revealed in a series of exhib-its which J. J. Pelley, President of the Association of American Railroads, recently presented to the special Senate Committee investigating Unemployment Relief.

For the nation as a w these exhibits showed that , year purchases of materials, plies and fuel amounting total of \$900,000,000 were by the railroads in 12,174 and towns located in 2,637 ties of a total of 3,027 count the 48 states of the nation. purchases included approxi 70.000 different items and affected industry and agricul everywhere.

In 1929 and 1930 railway chases of materials, supplies fuel averaged \$1,185,000,000 nually. In the five years from 1931 to 1935 this yearly averaged dropped to\$559,819,800. In 1930 railway purchases of material supplies and fuel increased to \$803,421,00. Encouraging traf-fic volume in the first half of 1937 resulted in a further increa in railway purchases of materials supplies and fuel, the total for the year amountin \$960,000,000
