BETTER FARMING FOR BETTER LIVING

Enrollments for the Better Farming for Better Living farm and home improvement contest in 13 Southeastern North Carolina Counties will be completed by May 1st. Excellent progress has been reported by Bladen, Duplin, Craven, Onslow, Jones, Pender and Pamlico Counties.

One of the objectives for Better Farming for Better Living is to encourage diversification. There is a definite place for live stock development in this area of the State. This phase of the program received a boost in two recent events. The Kinston Fat Stock Show and the Dairy Field Day at the Coastal Plains Experimental Farm at Willard.

The Kinston Fat Stock Show not only encouraged baby beef and hog production, but encouraged farm boys and girls who are members of 4-H Clubs and FFA - 104 baby beef steers were shown. Although baby beef production may not be of too much importance in this part of the State as compared with grazing areas, it does provide excellent education for boys and girls in the feeding, fitting and showing of animals, and at the same time provide some high quality beef. The Grand Champion steer was shown by a Wayne County 4-H boy. The hog show was an outstanding part of the Kinston event. 76 fat hogs were exhibited.

Preceding the Kinston event Duplin County exhibited their 25 baby calves in Kenansville. Then went on to Kinston and won the County award for the best group of five animals in the show. Victor Taylor, a Duplin boy, had the reserve champion steer at Kinston. Joe Bass, another Duplin 4-H'r, was adjudged best Showman in Kenansville and won second place in the Kinston contest.

The Dairy Field Day Held on Thursday, April 17 at the Coastal Plains Experiment Station at Willard was attended by nearly 400 farmers and farm leaders from surrounding counties. Dairy specialists at the meeting brought out the

great need for dairying in this part of the State and indicated that the greater part of our milk supply comes not only from the Piedmont Section but from out of the State. Wilmington alone could easily consume the milk production from more than 100 twenty cow herds.
