Approximately one-half of the dairy cows ration is used in repairing worn out tissue and maintaining body heat and energy. This is known as the maintenance ration and for it the dairyman receives no direct return. It must be supplied, however, before the cow can perform the functions for which she is kept.

In order that a ration may be palatable it must be pleasing to the cow's taste.

The USDA proposes to amend the regulations of its meat inspection service by adding to them a list of foreign countries eligible to export meat and meat food products to the United States.

## Fertilizer Inspection Was Big Help To N. C. Farmers

Rigid enforcement of the N. C. Fertilizer Law by the State Department of Agriculture resulted in Tar Heel farmers getting excess plant food value of \$1,017,370 above the guaranteed analysis of fertilizers purchased during 1946-7 fiscal year Assistant Commissioner D. S. Coltrane has announced.

During the last fiscal year, the inspectors ran 7,804 tests of samples representing 1,020,314 bags of fertilizer. Penalties amounting to \$30,608 were assessed against the manufacturers in 786 cases in which the fertilizer was found of lower grade than its guarantee certified.

By strict enforcement of the law the department has enabled farmers to buy quality fertilizer that is correctly and plainly labeled, and at the same time protect the honest manufacturer against dishonest competition.

Before any brand of fertilizer is offered for sale in the State, it must be registered with the Department. Each registration is carefully examined as to material used and guarantees, which must be in accordance with the law. Numerous applications for registration are declined each year until changes or corrections are made.

A. No.

Q. May I be furnished with a wheel-chair by the VA?

A. es, if you have a service-connected disability requiring the use of a wheel-chair.

Q. How long do I have to begin a course of training under the G-I Bill?

A. Four years from last July, 25.

Q. I had an arm amputated because of injuries received in the army. Can I select the type of artificial arm I want and the firm I want to buy it from?

A. You will be permitted to select the artificial arm of your choice but it must be purchased from an approved prosthetic appliance manufacturer under contract with the VA.
