Drivers License Issued In October

Driver's license examiners re-

used a total of 31,577 licenses during October, the N. C. Dept. of Motor Vehicles reported. Of the number 27,264 were issued on new applications. 216 were duplicates on old applications and 2,694 were duplicates on new applications.

Chauffeur's license for 1950-51 issued during October numbered 1,788. Not revenue from issuance of licenses was \$89,490.25, with \$54,964.50 coming from original operator's licenses, \$5,422.50 from original chauffeur's licenses and \$1,492.25 from duplicate operator's and chauffeur's licenses.
