Insects Destroy 35 Per Cent Of N. C. Cotton Crop

Insect damage to the 1950 cotton crop in North Carolina amounted to approximately \$46,150,000, destroying \$5 per cent of the total harvest, according to an estimate compiled by the National Cotton

Insects kept approximately 196,a 000 beles of cotton and an estimated 83,000 tons of cottonseed off the market this year. Based on average prices, this lint would have brought some \$39,116,000 and the seed would have meant an additional profit of \$7,032,000, Council spokesmen said.
