NASHVILLE -- Workshops for pastors, educational directors and other persons interested in beginning or continuing church-related work with the mentally retarded will be held July 21-27 and July 28-Aug. 3rd at Ridgecrest (N. C.) Baptist Assembly.

The daily schedule during the workshop will include a study of the nature of mental retardation and the use of curriculum materials specially prepared for workers with the mentally retarded. Observation in a laboratory classroom will be a special feature of the workshops.

Mrs. Doris Monroe, editor of primary materials in the Baptist Sunday School Board's Training Union Department, Nashville, will direct the workshops. She will be assisted by specialists in the area of mental retardation.
