

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD JUNE 20, 1970

TO DETERMINE WHETHER TO INCORPORATE THE TOWN OF COOLEEMEE, Davie County

SECTION ONE: Pursuant to Chapter 959, Session Laws of 1969, the Board of Elections of Davie County herewith calls a special election on June 20, 1970, to submit to the qualified voters of the area hereinafter described as the proposed corporate limits of the Town of Coolee, the question whether or not such area shall be incorporated as a municipal corporation known as the Town of Coolee, North Carolina, and to elect the members of the governing body if said area is incorporated.

SECTION TWO: A new registration of all qualified voters in the described area shall be conducted for the purpose of registering the names of those who desire to vote in such special election: the area of the proposed corporate boundaries of Coolee is as follows:

BEGINNING at River Bridge, Highway 801 in Rowan County, follow South Yadkin

Students Assigned

The Davie County Board of Education, at its regular meeting on Monday, May 4, 1970, adjusted certain attendance areas and assigned students for the 1970-71 school year.

All students living in Davie County in grades 9 - 12 are assigned to Davie County High School. All students in grades 1 - 8, with the exception of some special education students, are assigned to the elementary school in the attendance area in which they live.

The need to adjust attendance area lines became necessary because of the consolidation of the Farmington and Smith Grove Schools into the Pinebrook Elementary School, and the inclusion of grades 6, 7, and 8 at William R. Davie School. The Board of Education has attempted to use natural boundary lines wherever possible, and to establish lines so that a minimum number of students will be affected.

River upstream to "Cowpasture Branch", just beyond River Dam. Follow Branch to point adjacent to Church Street Extension, then to a point Northwest end of Hickory Street, then to include all property adjoining Hickory Street to intersection of Hickory Street and State Road No. 1128 and all property adjoining State Road No. 1128 to Highway 801; then all property adjoining Highway 801 to intersection at Midway Street to Center Street; then go Southwest on centerline of Center Street to point approximately 200 feet from Midway Street. At this point, all adjoining property on Center Street to Holt Street. Include all property adjoining Holt Street, North on line to River Bridge at BEGINNING POINT.

SECTION THREE: The registrar for the precinct election is Annette Anderson; the two judges of the election are Jo Creason and Granville Spry; the polling place for the special election will be Coolee Elementary School.

SECTION FOUR: The registration book for such new registration shall be open for 30 days prior to the election and shall remain open on each day from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. at the home or business of the registrar. On Saturday, May 23, 30, and June 6, the registration books will be open at the polling place from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Saturday, June 13, 1970, will be Challenge Day at the polling place. On election day the polls shall be kept open from 6:30 a.m. until 6:30 p.m.

SECTION FIVE: The candidates for election to the Town Board of Commissioners must file with the Board notice of candidacy not later than 12:00 noon on May 21, 1970.

Any qualified voter who would offer himself as a candidate for commissioner in such election shall file with the Chairman or Clerk of the Board of Elections of Davie County a written statement giving notice of his candidacy in substantially the following form:

I, _____, do hereby given notice that I am a candidate for election to the office of Commissioner, Town of Coolee, to be voted on at the election on June 20, 1970 and I hereby request that my name be placed on the official ballot for such office. I certify that I am a

SECTION SIX: In the special election, those voters who favor the incorporation of the Town of Coolee shall vote a ballot upon which shall be printed the words: "FOR Incorporation of Town of Coolee," and those voters who are opposed to the incorporation of Town of Coolee shall vote a ballot upon which shall be printed the words: "AGAINST Incorporation of Town of Coolee."

Also in the special election each qualified voter shall be entitled to vote for five (5) candidates for Commissioner upon a ballot on which shall be listed, in alphabetical order, the names of all persons who filed notice of candidacy with the Board of Elections during the period hereinabove established.

IF A MAJORITY of the votes cast in such special election shall be cast "AGAINST" Incorporating of Town of Coolee," then the preceding paragraph shall have no force and effect.

In the special election the three (3) candidates for Commissioner who receive the largest number of votes cast for Commissioner shall be declared elected for terms of four (4) years or until their successors are elected and qualified, and the two (2) candidates for Commissioner who receive the next largest numbers of votes cast for Commissioners shall be declared elected for terms of two (2) years or until their successors are elected and qualified. In case of a tie between opposing candidates, the Board of Elections shall determine the result by lot.
