Injured Ijames Scores 11 Points; Davie Fourth

A back injury hampered Davie County's star performer James Ijames in the Western North Carolina High School Activities Association track meet on Saturday, but he scored 11 points and Davie tied for fourth place in the meet.

Ijames recorded his worst times in the hurdles events, running 16.0 in the 120 highs and taking fourth. He took sixth in the 180 lows, but his time was not recorded.

The 6-5 Rebel was fourth in

the 220 with a time of 23.2, and fourth in the 100 with a 10.1 clocking.

Jerry Goodlett took Davie's only first place of the day, winning the triple jump with a distance of 44-2 3/4.

Andy Atwell captured second in the mile run with a time of 4:43, and Alan Barger was second in the shot put with a heave of 54-4 3/4. Barger was also sixth in the discus with a throw of 134.3 1/2.
