ALL MINOR POLITICAL PARTIES TRYING TO UNITE UNDER ONE BANNER.

COMMITTEE OF FORTY-EIGHT

Speaker Said Day Will Come When People of America Will Do as Good a Job as Russians.

Chicago.—Amalgamation of the minor political movements under the banner of a third party drew a step nearer when the labor party of the United States opened its second national convention with representatives of many other organizations present. The committee of 48 and the single single tax conventions were in recess, but attended the labor convention in recess.

John Fitzpatrick, president of the Chicago Federation of Labor, a keynote speaker, brought the convention to the highest enthusiasm with a plea "that the day would come when the working people of the United States would get together and do a job such as the workers of Russia have done." The biggest demonstration of the day was recorded this reference. The thunder of foot stamping and cheering punctuated the Fitzpatrick address. His speech lost all repression in its reference to Russia and Ireland, and to the republican and democratic parties.
