U. S. Department of Commerce makes Statement Concerning the Cotton Crop

The Carry over of Cotton to the United States on July 31st, 1922, was 2,528,186 bales compared with 6,534,360 bales for 1921, and 3,563,162 bales for 1920. Based on the average consumption for the past year, the mill stocks 1,215,193 bales, will meet the consumptive requirements of the domestic mills for 7 1/2 weeks.

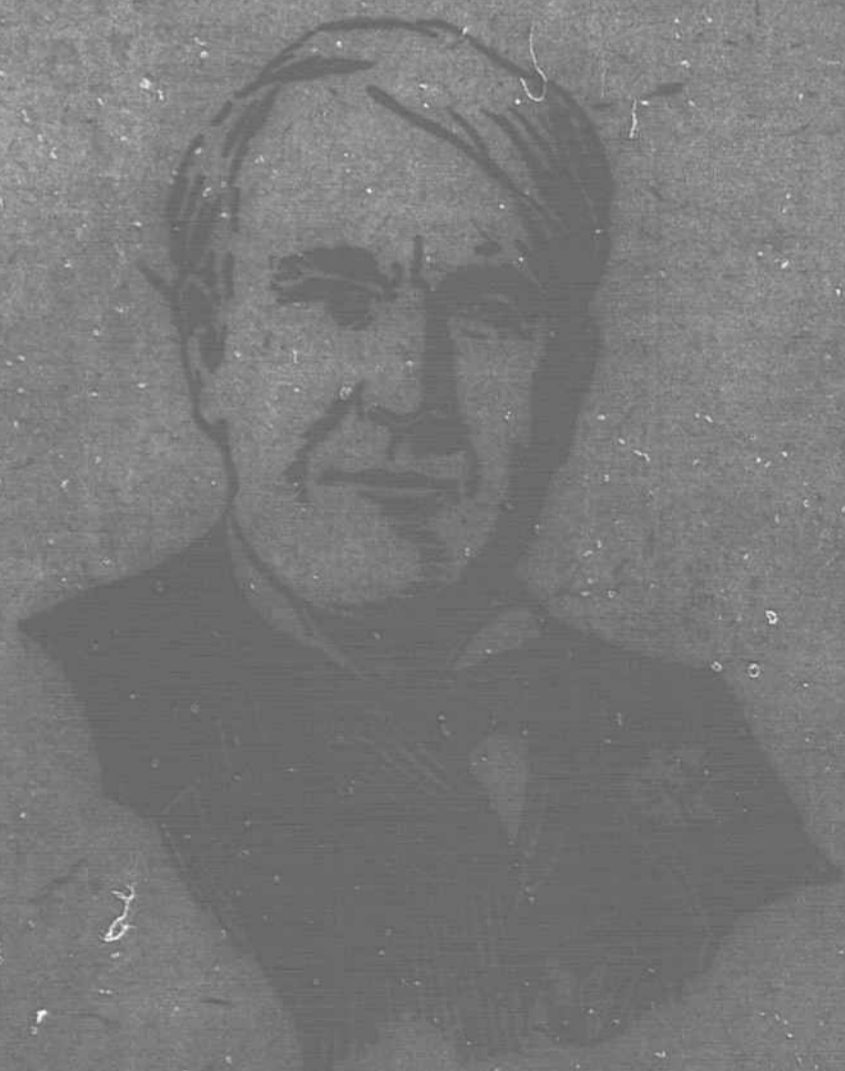
