France is now being required to pay four hundred million franks (\$8,000,000) every day for the maintenance of the Nazi Army that occupies the country and wages war against England from French soil. In addition, France has to pay for the upkeep of two million French prisoners, still in the Reich, where they are working for the benefit of the Nazi government.
