(Christian Science Monitor) Two editorials lie before us, re- Gay. printed and distributed by Licensed Beverage Industries, Inc., the publicity arm of the liquor trade. Both of them are from reputable metropolitan newspapers, esteemed and prominent in their respective fields.

These editorials have accepted, al line of argument that big consumption of liquor helps education because of the big taxes collectedand part education for American children.

We do not question the sincerity of these editorials. These newspapers may be honestly persuaded by the liquor industry's reasoning as we are honestly not. That isn't the whole story, however.

Unless signs fail, curbs on the liquor industry, probably short of prohibition but more drastic than anything before or since that era, will become a national issue sooner than the average American realizes. The Capper bill, which would outlaw interstate advertising of alcoholic beverages, is but one straw in the wind.

American newspapers, if they remain true to their trust, will have to discuss this issue. And the Capper bill has already presented them with a very large question, which will grow more acute as time goes on: How clean will their hands be? How many of them will be able to stand up before their readers as impartial independent advocates of the public good? The integrity of their editorial policy actually may be above reproach. But tremendous displays of liquor advertising within the same pages day after day, month after month, raise doubts in the public mind that will be hard to argue
