(Christian Science Monitor) Two editorials lie before us, reprinted and distributed by Licensed Beverage Industries, Inc., the publicity arm of the liquor trade.

These editorials have accepted, almost without reservation, the LBI's line of argument that big consumption of liquor helps education because of the big taxes collected.

We do not question the sincerity of these editorials. These newspapers may be honestly persuaded by the liquor industry's reasoning as we are honestly not. That isn't the whole story, however.

Unless signs fail, curbs on the liquor industry, probably short of prohibition but more drastic than anything before or since that era, will become a national issue sooner than the average American realizes.

American newspapers, if they remain true to their trust, will have to discuss this issue. And the Capper bill has already presented them with a very large question, which will grow more acute as time goes on.
