EMPLOY THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED WEEK'

President Truman, Governor Cherry and many of the mayors of towns and cities in North Carolina have issued proclamations designating the week of October 5-11 as "National Employ the Physically Handi-capped Week," a week during which the North Carolina State Employment Service Division, the Veterans Employment Service, the Vocational Rehabilitation forces, the American Legion and other service and patriotic organipations will seek to find suitable jobs for many of the trained handicapped workers in the State.

"The problem," said Henry E. Kendall, chairman of the Employment Security Commission of North Carolina, "is not keeping the handicapped worker on the job he has, but placing him in a job that will utilize his abilities. Statistics show that the disabled worker's employment stability is much better than that of a normal worker. When selective placement is used, by which he is fitted into a job in which his handicaps will not be handicaps, the handicapped worker is almost certain to stay on
