DAVENPORT AND TRIPP ARE NAMED DIRECTORS OF PCA

Over 200 members of the Greenville Production Credit Association attended their 14th annual stockholders' meeting at Greenville on Friday, Dec. 5.

J. P. Davenport of Pactolus and Jesse L. Tripp of Ayden, Route 1, were elected directors by the stockholders. John R. Carroll, president, presided over the meeting and Jesse L. Tripp gave the report for the Board of Directors.

Secretary-Treasurer F. L. Little, Jr., reported that the association had made 773 loans totaling \$1,335,800 and that reserves in the amount of \$84,009.16 had been built up to protect the members' investment.

Director D. F. Hardison made a talk concerning future plans for the association.

S. C. Lattimore, vice president of the Production Credit Corporation and Federal Land Bank of Columbia, gave an informative and interesting address at this meeting. He congratulated the membership on the progress made by the Greenville Association and the service that it has rendered to farmers in Pitt and Greene counties.

He encouraged the stockholders to continue supporting the PCA and pointed out the need for the services of the farmer-owned organization in the future.

In addition to the stockholders, 20 guests were in attendance.

POSTER TELLS SOLDIERS HOW TO SPOT COMMUNISTS

United States authorities in Germany have issued a series of pamphlets and posters warning American soldiers against Communists as "ruthless conspirators" and telling them "how to spot a Communist."

With the pamphlets entitled "The Communist Menace" goes a large red poster for display on bulletin boards which says:

How to spot a Communist.
The party line—if he echoes it, he's probably a Communist.
The Communist press—if he endorses it, he's probably a Communist.
The Communist policy—if he supports it, he's probably a Communist.
If he does all three, he is a Communist.

The issue of these pamphlets follows closely on the recent announcement by Gen. Lucius D. Clay, United States Military Governor in Germany, of an "anti-Communist" propaganda campaign.

Drawn up by the United States Army Information and Education Branch in Germany, they make the following points:

Communists, working individually and as a group, are working underground; their effort is designed to eliminate majority rule, for they know they are outnumbered.

They are ruthless conspirators. They feel theirs is a holy cause. Consequently, ethics and morals mean nothing to them.

They are vicious name-callers and character assassins.

Detailing political events in eastern Europe and declaring even small numbers of Communists dangerous, the pamphlets support their arguments as follows:

Romania: 450,000 Communists, only 7 per cent of the population, run the Government.

Romania: 500,000 Communists about 3 per cent of the population, run the Government.

Yugoslavia: A handful of Titoed Communists have come to control the Government and Yugoslavia's 16,000,000 people.
