Tough In First Half; Hoke Band Also Stars

The Sanford Yellow Jackets finished its 1968 season with a spotless 10-0 record here Friday night, but it had trouble with the Hoke High Bucks for two periods. The halftime score was 7-0.

Sanford pulled away, after a third period Buck score, to win 33-6.

The halftime show by the Hoke High Band was the best of the season. Jimmy James, hand director, deserves plenty of credit for the outstanding performance of the band during the year.

The Yellow Jackets, Southeastern 3-A and defending state champions, struck first in the initial stanza as they drove 73 yards in six plays, climaxed when quarterback Tommy Haislip tossed a 10-yard scoring pass to Glenn Taylor, Jay Overton kicked the extra point.

Overton attempted a field goal in the second period, but missed and the halftime score remained 7-0 Sanford.

But the Yellow Jackets exploded for two tallies in each of the remaining segments to turn the contest into a rout In the third period, after a 79-yard drive, Haislip plunged the final yard to paydirt. In the last seconds of that period, Steve Jones capped a 61-yard

drive when he scampered four yards for his first tally of the evening. Raeford scratched its lone tally in that period. Wilbert McNair recovered a fumble on the Sanford 24-yard line and seven plays later Donnie Rose powered

the final yard to paydirt.

In the final segment it was Haislip and

Jones again. Haislip capped a 73-yard

drive by scampering six yards for his second tally of the contest.

With 2:55 left in the game, Jones rambled five yards for his second touchdown. This score was set up moments earlier when Jay Overton recovered a fumble on the Raeford 25-yard line.

Taylor carried 24 times for Sanford and gained 184 yards. Jones ran 12 times for 89 yards. For Raeford, Rose carried
