First and second honorable mention were chosen from each school with cash prizes of \$7.50 and \$5. All participants received a "Certificate of Participation."



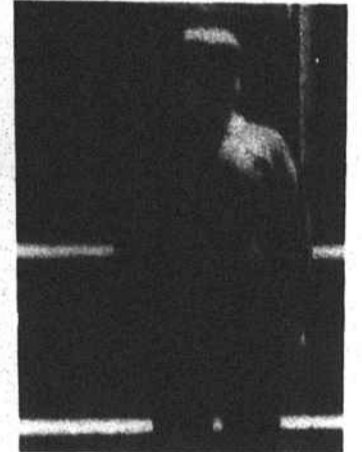
