Three HHS students attend state Close Up

On May 17, 18 & 19 approximately 350 students and teachers gathered in Raleigh for North Carolina CLOSE UP.

Area representatives who were among the participants included Robert Barefoot, Brenda Hendren, Nancy McNeill and their teacher coordinator, Alona McNeill.

North Carolina CLOSE UP began in 1978. It is an educational program which was designed to allow students and their teachers to interact with state officials, legislators, representatives from the news media, lobbyist organizations, etc. through panel discussions, seminars, question and answer sessions, etc. The program is modeled after the highly suc-

cessful National Close Up program which provides opportunities for teachers and students to use Washington as a classroom in the same manner that Raleigh is used for the North Carolina program.

North Carolina CLOSE UP is now in its seventh year of operation. It is governed and operated by a working advisory committee of teachers and administrators from North Carolina school systems and by the Social Studies Division of the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction.

Approximately 140 high schools including the North Carolina School for the Deaf will be participating in this year's program.

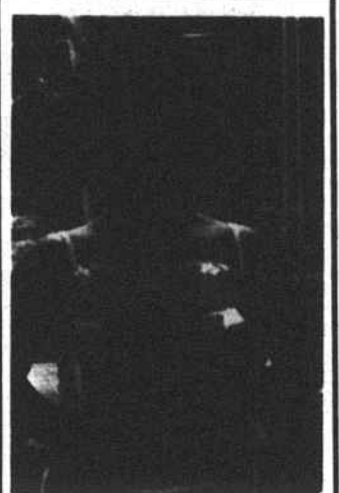
