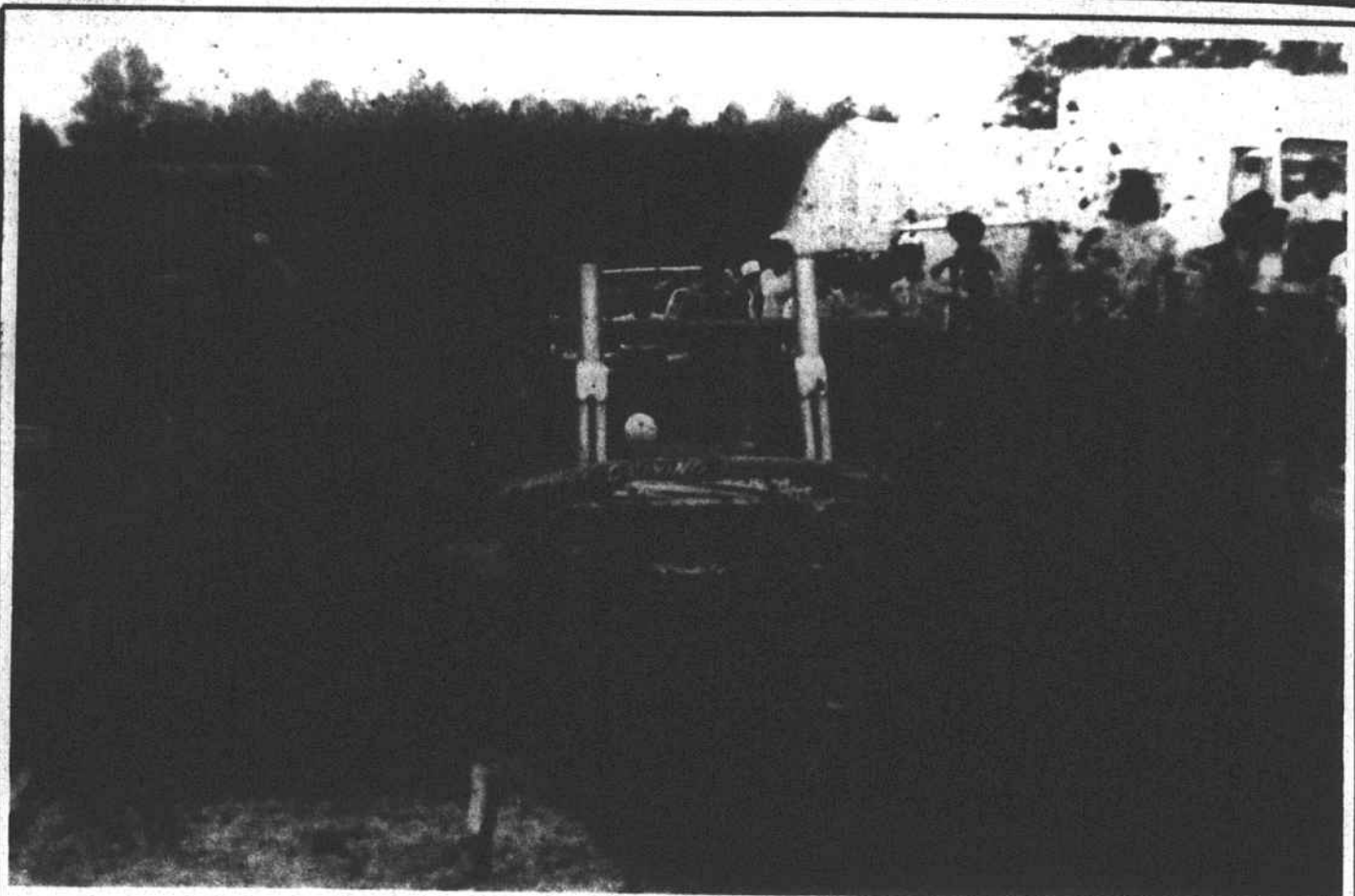


Sports
