Topping a 8 oz. pkg. cream cheese (softened)

1 teaspoon vanilla flavoring

1/2 cup sour cream

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 cup chopped nuts Dissolve gelatin in hot water. Add crushed pineapple (do not drain) and cherry pie filling. Mix well. Pour in 2 quart casserole dish and refrigerate until congealed (2 hours or overnight). To prepare topping; Cream together softened cream cheese and sour cream. Blend in sugar and vanilla. Spread on top of congealed mixture. Sprinkle with chopped nuts. Refrigerate until ready to serve. Serves 8.

## SCARLET CHICKEN
