Leukemia most deadly disease for felines

DEAR DOCTOR: Recently my one and one half year-old male cat had to be put to sleep because of feline leukemia. I also have a two and one half year-old female who seems perfectly healthy. Shortly before my male cat became ill, we mated him with another cat. She had three kittens, one of which died. My question is, what are the chances of my female, the other female and kitten of having feline leukemia?

ANSWER: Feline leukemia is really a complex of diseases of cats caused by a virus. The feline leukemia virus causes the most important fatal infectious diseases in our domestic cats in America to-

day.

The virus is spread between cats living in close contact with each other and can be passed by the mother to her kittens while they are still in the uterus. Between adults cats, the virus is probably spread by the saliva through grooming and sneezing. At the pre-sent time, there is no evidence that implicates feline leukemia virus

with human disease.

Cats that have a disease caused by the feline leukemia virus may have cancer that affects the blood

cells, may produce solitary tumors, or they might have a tumor that affects any of the major organs of the bcdy. Another way a cat with a feline leukemia virus disease might show that disease is through infertility, abortion or loss of kittens early in life.

In addition to causing diseases itself, the virus depresses the immune system of the cat and makes it more vulnerable to infections that otherwise might be just minor problems.

Not all cats that are exposed to the virus and get the disease will develop life threatening problems. Many cats are able to fight off the virus and develop an immunity against it. This gives hope for a vaccine that is currently undergo-

ing final tests and approval. If you have a cat that is diagnosas having a positive Feline Leukemia Virus test, you may elect to do nothing, treat the animal to keep it alive for as long as possible, or have the pet put to sleep. If there are other cats in the household, they should have a blood test for the virus.
