NC Natural Gas earnings rise

Earning of \$2.89 per share for fiscal 1984 were reported recently by North Carolina Natural Gas Corporation.

Net income amounted to \$4,941,000.

This compares with last year's restated net income of \$2,786,000, or a \$1.63 per share.
The 1984 earnings were adjusted

by \$591,000 after taxes, or \$.35 per share to reflect a write-down of the

company's investment in explora-tion activities. According to Frank Barragan Jr., Company President, this year's higher earnings can be at-tributed to a general rate increase

in December of 1983, a significant increase in sales volume to high priority customers, the improved economy and colder than normal weather.
