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visitors may pick up plastic "I Love Zoo' tote bags at the ticket Depending on the weather, the gorillas will be at home in their quarter-acre indoor habitat, or their half-acre outdoor habitat. about 150 other African animals and 3,300 exotic plants and trees. Among the other animal species on exhibit in the 55,000 -squarefoot pavilion are Patas monkey, mandrill, gerenuk, Black-backed

African Pavilion and African Plains, a 40 -acre habitat Aor antelope and large, ground
