Hoke runners place 4th in 4-A conference meet

The Hoke County High School Boys Track Team continued its roll and finished fourth in a conference meet last week at Scotland County High School.

According to Coach Howard Barkley, there were two "all conference" selections made from the team.

Terrell Carpenter was chosen in the long jump and the members of the 800 meter relay team were also chosen for the honors.

Carpenter, John Baker, Marco Pickett and Darcey Cunningham are the members of the team.

Each team member will receive all conference recognition, said Barkley.

During the meet, the relay team broke another school record with a time of 1 minute, 28.5 seconds.

According to Barkley, this is the second fastest time turned in the state so far this year.

Terrell Carpenter fell second to his arch-rival and state champ in the 100 meters.

Tim Worley and Carpenter were neck and neck down to the line, said Barkley.

John Baker placed third in that event and also captured second in the 200 meter dash.

Distance runner Don Woods placed second in the 1,600 and 3,200 meter runs, according to Barkley.

Marco Pickett placed fifth in the high jump.

Tom Galdy and Bobby Little placed seventh in the discus and triple jump respectively.
