The tents donated by the Jaycees will enable the troop leaders to increase outdoor program opportunities to troop members.

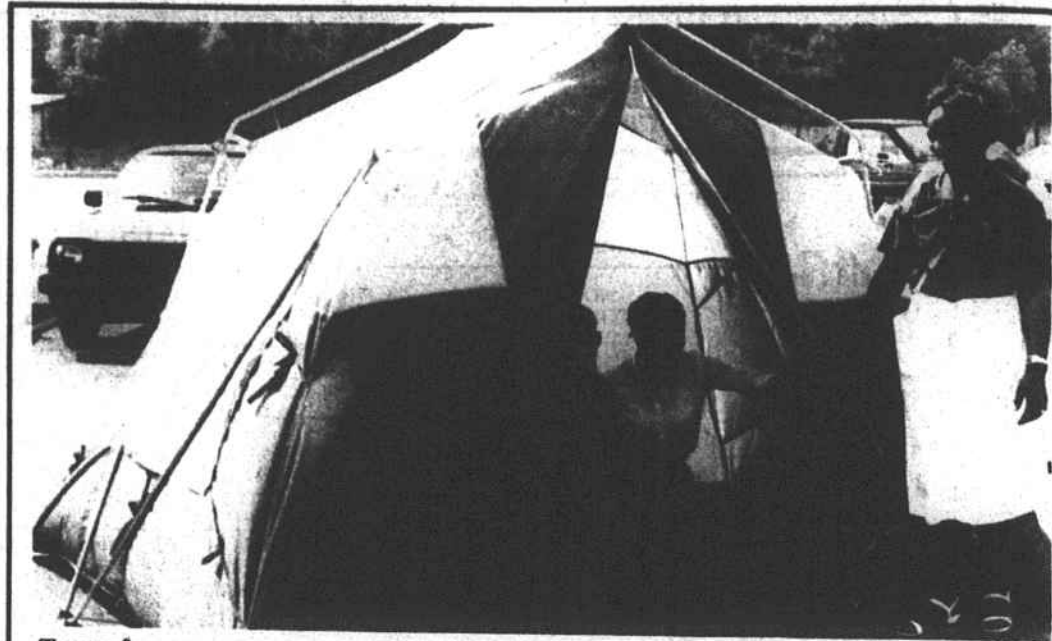

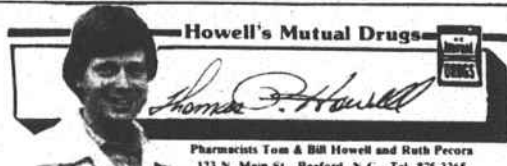
