Dr. Ephraim Stam, NCSU professor of nuclear engineering, directed the program. He and other nuclear engineering faculty taught classes and laboratory sessions which introduced the students to nuclear science and its application to technology.

Participants became familiar with the facilities of NCSU Department of Nuclear Engineering, including the PULSTAR research reactor and the com-

puterized neutron activation analysis laboratory. Radioactivity, nuclear reactions, nuclear energy, nuclear reactors and the study and practice of nuclear engineering were among topics covered during the program.

The high school students were selected to attend the program on the basis of their academic records and SAT scores.




