

Hoke senior attends workshop

Twenty-six North Carolina rising high school seniors, including one from Hoke County, interested in engineering or science careers have completed a two-week summer program in nuclear science and technology at North Carolina State University.

Dr. Ephraim Stam, NCSU professor of nuclear engineering, directed the program. He and other nuclear engineering faculty taught classes and laboratory sessions which introduced the students to nuclear science and its application to technology.

The high school students were selected to attend the program on the basis of their academic records and SAT scores.
