McCallum has taught at Upchurch Jr. High and Hoke County High Schools for 16 years.

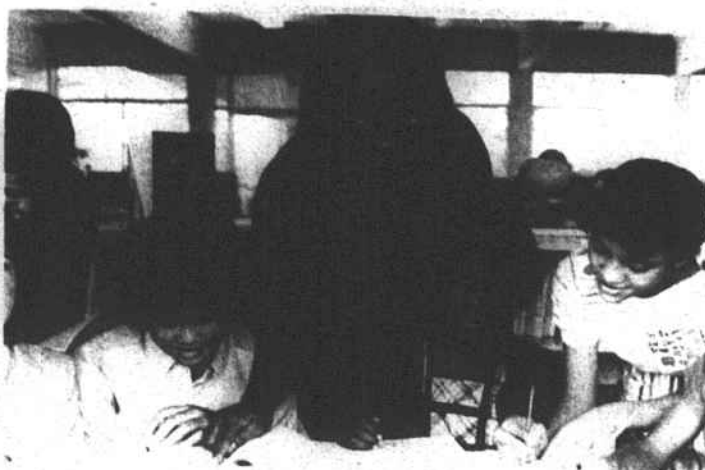
In addition to her teaching responsibilities, McCallum is very active in the North Carolina Association for Educators on the State and Local levels.
