## **Extension Service offers** counseling for farm woes

The optimism that prevailed throughout the farm scene in the 1970's has been replaced by a growing sense of pessimism that things will never quite be the same again, says Willie Featherstone, Hoke County Extension Chair-

Many of today's problems, low farm prices, declining land values, tight credit, resulted from decisions made during the 70's. Decisions that seemed right back then.

Placing the blame for the cur-rent situation has become an obsession today. Some blame government policies; others blame general economic conditions. But too many farmers facing financial stress are putting the blame on themselves. And that can get in the way of making critical decisions that need to be made now, Featherstone points out.


