Extension Service offers counseling for farm woes

The optimism that prevailed throughout the farm scene in the 1970's has been replaced by a growing sense of pessimism that things will never quite be the same again, says Willie Featherstone, Hoke County Extension Chairman.

Many of today's problems, low farm prices, declining land values, tight credit, resulted from decisions made during the 70's. Decisions that seemed right back then.

Placing the blame for the current situation has become an obsession today. Some blame government policies; others blame general economic conditions. But too many farmers facing financial stress are putting the blame on themselves. And that can get in the way of making critical decisions that need to be made now, Featherstone points out.

Farm families looking for help in sorting out their options can pick up the telephone and dial 1-800-7NC-FARM.

Operators can provide confiden-

tial information, referrals and counseling for farm and family financial problems, legal options and individual and family problems, Featherstone adds. They are on duty from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

This toll-free telephone consulting service is just one of the many helps offered by the N.C. Agricultural Extension Service, Featherstone adds.

Agents in the local agricultural extension office at 314 S. Magnolia Street, can provide complementary information.
