Remainder of Order Numbers Published; Surry's Quota Is Six

First Number Is Order Number, Second Is Serial Number;
of Six men to be Called for Service in December,
Three Are from Draft Area No. 2, Which In-
cludes Elkin; No Colored Men to be
Called in First Group from
This County

The names, order numbers and serial numbers of the registrants in Surry draft area No. 2, which is made up of all townships in the county with the exception of Mount Airy, Stewarts Creek and Long Hill, appear herewith.

It must be remembered, in checking the list, that the first number is the order number and the second number the serial number. The order number determines the order in which registrants will be called for service.

Registrants may easily find their own order number by looking up their serial number in this list, as the serial numbers run consecutively. If they do not know their serial numbers they will have to search until they find their names.

Five hundred names and numbers appeared in last week's Tribune, and are not republished in this list.

Surry county's draft quota to be called in December numbers only six men, voluntary enlistments having cut the figure to that number. Of these six, three will be called from this draft area.

Under the quota, only 513 men will be called from the entire state. However, it was said by state selective headquarters that volunteers may fill all first call requirements.

The three men subject to call by draft board No. 2 will be all white. The three from the No. 1 area will also be white men.

In Yadkin county three white men and no colored men will be called. In Wilkes county, two white men will be called from No. 1, and three from No. 2. Alleghany will furnish one white man and no colored.
