LONDON, Sept. 2—Russian embassy has announced that Russian "Slowly advancing toward Lorraine where a regular siege of German entrenched positions was in progress driving the Germans back for the last two days. They suffered partial checks at Meuse and Chatan Paliseul district. They compelled the French to withdraw their lines near Meuse. The left wing was attacked by a greatly superior force in Chateau Cumbrai district and retired southdarw.
