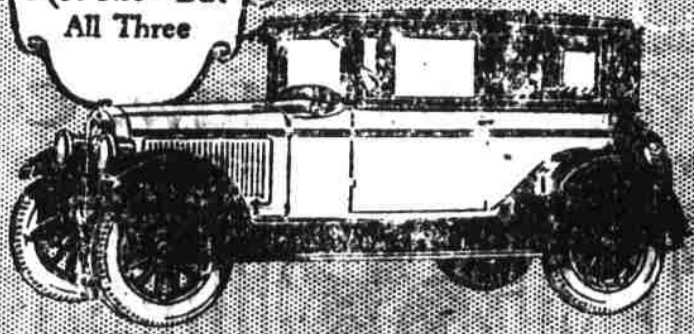

Marriages in the United States are increasing at the rate of 8.4 per cent, while divorces register a gain of 11 per cent, according to statistics gathered by the United States census bureau. Marriages still outnumber divorces, however, with 1,344,573 in the entire country in 1923 against 165,228 divorces in the same period. The lowest birth rate in the country is 14.9 per 1,000 population in the rural sections of Montana, while the highest is in the rural section of North Carolina with 31.9 per 1,000 population. The total death rate for the country has decreased from 12.4 per 1,000 population to 11.9 per 1,000.
