We have now the Meeklenburg road law as adopted by the county commissioners of Polk
county in the year 1902 This low is found in the Acts of 1901, chapter 50 . In 1903 while in the egislature I amended our road law as then adopted by striking thec, te peace should on thust day of April in each year apoint ay of April in each year appoint hip, giving this power to the ship, giving this power to the county.
After having tried this for two years I thought it best to have the power of the appointment justices of the peace, so I asked the legislature of North Carolina at their recent session to repea chapter 458 (the amendment) of the Acts of 1903 relative to the road law of Polk county, which was done, This, of course, leaves the poik county road law as it originally was, giving to the justices of the peace in each township the right and power to meet on the last Monday in April and elect the road trustees for their respective townships. the justices of the peace and I trust that they will meet and elect good men for this publi duty,
