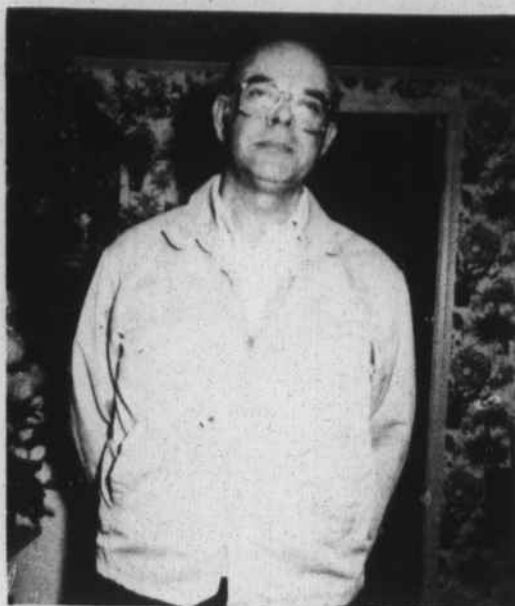


Duplin Duplicate Bridge Club Holds Opening Game
