### WROUGHT IRON FURNITURE

If you're buying wrought iron furniture for your patio, make sure it'll be easy to clean, have low maintenance costs and will stand up to wind, rain and sunlight.

Good quality wrought iron furniture should carry a guarantee against rust. And you might ask if a touch-up kit is included.

Also check the furniture to make sure that there are smooth welds at the joints and that the decorations are secure.

When you get your furniture home, keep it in top condition by hosing it down, or washing it with warm water and a mild detergent. Be sure to rinse.

Rub scratches or rust spots with steel wool and apply a metal primer coat. Be sure to use touch-up paint on chipped or scraped spots. And keep in mind that an annual coat of paste wax will help to preserve the color of the wrought-iron finish.

### Taking Care Of The Bills

If you're a person with too much month and not enough money, don't panic. There are some things you can do to get your finances straightened out.

The first thing is to realize exactly where you stand. Make a list of all your bills and then figure out how much of your income you can use to pay them off.

Next, look for ways to increase your income. Can you sell some things that you no longer use? Could you turn a hobby or skill into a money-maker?

Then, if you've worked out all the possibilities for additional income and still come up short of funds, talk with your creditors.

Explain your problem to them. Often creditors are willing to accept smaller payments over a longer period.

Once you work out a short term solution, take a look at your bill payment pattern. If you often have too many bills with too little money, take a good look at where your money is going. Keep records of what you buy and figure out ways to spend less. You might find a written spending plan helpful.

Last, but not least, get the cooperation of your whole family in sticking to the financial game plan. No one will feel cheated if he has helped decide what to buy and what to avoid.

## General Assembly Honors Former Representative Baker

Both houses of the North Carolina General Assembly, in a joint resolution, honored the life and memory of Thomas James Baker last Monday night by unanimous vote of the House and Senate. Representative Wendell H. Murphy of Rose Hill, who introduced the measure, spoke on the resolution, outlining the dedication and contribution to the county and state which reflected Rep. Baker's career of public service, spanning 34 years before his death on January 19, 1981.

Also speaking favorable on the resolution were friends and colleagues of former Rep. Baker, including: Rep. Edward C. Bowen, (D-Sampson) of Harrells; Rep. Vernon James, (D-Pasquotank) of Elizabeth City; Rep. Dan Lilley (D-Lenoir) of Kinston; Rep. Aaron Fussell, (D-Wake) of Raleigh; Rep. Richard Wright, (D-Columbus) of Tabor city; Rep. Margaret Tennille, (D-Forsyth) of Winston-Salem; Rep. Allen Barbee (D-Nash) of Spring Hope; Rep. John Brown, (R-Wilkes) of Elkin, and Rep. Barney Paul Woodard (D-Johnston) of Princeton.

In an impressive move in the Senate, Lt. Governor Jimmy Green spoke honoring Mr. Baker's memory, along with Sen. Harold Hardison, (D-Lenoir) of Deep Run; Sen. Kenneth C. Royall, Jr., (D-Durham) of Durham; and Sen. W. Craig Lawing, (D-Mecklenburg) of Charlotte.
