**CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL
for an
INDUSTRIAL PROJECT**

The Duplin County Industrial Facilities and Pollution Control Financing Authority
[For J.P. Stevens & Co., Inc.]
The undersigned, SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, of the State of North Carolina (the "Secretary"), pursuant to Section 159C-7 of the General Statutes of North Carolina and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary thereunder, DOES HEREBY CERTIFY, FIND AND DETERMINE as follows:

(a) The Duplin County Industrial Facilities and Pollution Control Financing Authority (the "Authority"), a political subdivision and body corporate and politic of the State of North Carolina created by resolution adopted by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Duplin, in accordance with Chapter 159C of the General Statutes of North Carolina (the "Act") has filed with the Secretary pursuant to Section 159C-7 of the Act and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary thereunder, an application for approval of its proposed industrial project (the "Project") which is to be financed, in part, by an issue of Industrial Revenue Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000.

(b) The Project consists of the acquisition, and installation of certain equipment and renovation in connection therewith at the existing facility of J.P. Stevens & Co., Inc. located in Duplin County. The Project will provide additional employment for approximately 238 people.

(c) Public notice of the Authority's submission of its application for approval was duly published in the manner required by the regulations prescribed by the Secretary and all comments received in accordance with such notice have been considered by the Secretary.

(d) As required by the third paragraph of G.S. 159C-7 of the Act, the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development has certified to the undersigned that the Project will not have a materially adverse effect on the environment.

Upon due consideration of the Authority's application for approval and the comments received with respect thereto, the Secretary hereby further CERTIFIES, FINDS AND DETERMINES as follows, pursuant to Section 159C-7 of the Act and the Regulations of the Secretary prescribed thereunder:

1. The Project is an industrial project for industry.
2. The operator of the Project will pay an average weekly manufacturing wage which is above the average weekly manufacturing wage paid in Duplin County.
3. The Project will not have a materially adverse effect on the environment.
4. The approximately 238 jobs to be generated directly by the Project will be large enough in number to have a measurable impact on the area immediately surrounding the Project and will be commensurate with the size and the cost of the Project.
5. The operator of the Project has demonstrated its capability to operate the Project.
6. The financing of the Project by the Authority will not cause or result in the abandonment of an existing industrial or manufacturing facility of the operator or an affiliate elsewhere within the State of North Carolina.
7. The Project is hereby approved and this Certificate of Approval shall become effective as provided in Section 159C-7 of the Act.
