TRASH PICTURE - It's ugly, it's unhealthy, and it's illegal. The Duplin County Board of Commissioners have said "Enough is enough." Trash containers are to be filled, trash is not to be thrown on the ground, and large appliances such as refrigerators are not to be placed in these trash containers. . And, anyone caught doing so will be fined in Duplin courts. The commissioners have instructed the sanitation workers to place notices on the green boxes (trash containers) telling of their instructions, and the Duplin County Sheriff and his deputies are to "keep an eye" on the containers about the county and strictly enforce the ordinance. Items too large for the containers are to be hauled to the county landfill near Rose Hill. There is no charge for using the landfill.
