
Smith Selected For Membership

Duplin Officials Capture Escapees

State Department of Corrections officials in Duplin County recaptured two escapted prisoners around 5:45 a.m. Thursday after more than 13 hours of searching.

Joey Tripp, 21, and Bobby Flake, 19, were found coming out of woods on N.C. 111 about 10 miles north of the State Prison Unit 4125 south of Kenansville, said prison Superintendent L.W. Parker.

Parker said one of 10 people assigned to the search found the prisoners while patrolling highways. Flake and Tripp jumped the fence at the minimum-security prison around 4:30 p.m. Wednesday.

Tripp was admitted to the prison last month and was serving an 18-month sentence for assault with a deadly weapon and for breaking and entering and larceny. Flake, also admitted last month, was serving a 4-year sentence for breaking and entering and larceny.
