## Wastewater Treatment Plant **Operators Certification Class**

A training course for Grades I and II wastewater treatment plant operators began Jan. 30 in the Hall Building on the James Sprunt Tech-nical College campus.

This program is sponsored jointly by the N.C. Division of Environ-mental Management, JSTC, and the N.C. Water Pollution Control Association.

The course consists of practical classroom and field training in the proper operation and maintenance of wastewater plants. Classes are held on Monday nights from 6-10 p.m. except the last month of the classes in which the class will meet both Monday and Wednesday nights. The primare purpose of the course will be to upgrade the skills and knowledge of the operators so that they will be able to get the greatest efficiency from the wastewater treatment plants and discharge a minimum of pollution into the streams of the state.
