Funds For Test Well Allocated In Albertson

The Albertson Water and Sewer District in northeastern Duplin County will drill a test well at a cost of \$3,500 using money obtained when people signed up as customers for the proposed water system.

The state requires a test well to be drilled in a proposed well field so the field's water quality and quantity can be determined. This must be done before any state or federal money will be released for the project.

The Duplin County Board of Commissioners, in its capacity as the district's governing board, approved use of the sign-up money for the test well.

The \$1,011,000 project will be financed by a Farmers Home Administration grant and loan of \$697,000 and a state clean water bond grant of \$314,000. A bond issue of \$425,000 was authorized in a recent referendum to finance the loan.

The commissioners also scheduled a public hearing at 10:15 a.m. May 7 on relocation of the proposed Rockfish community center.
