Don't forget the canned fruits and fruit juices as well as the many varieties of preserves and pickles and relishes. Remember there are standard types of containers to be used and generally points are scored on flavor, texture, color or clearness, and appearance compatible to variety processes.

Don't forget the categories for breads, cakes, cookies, candies and pies.

The clothing department will include aprons, blazers, blouses, dresses, gouchos, hats, housecoats, infant garments, jumpers, jumpsuits, shorts and skirts.

Needlework is always a perennial favorite with new crafts added each year. Everyone looks forward to seeing the afghans, quilts, bed spreads, bell pulls, crewel, cross stitch, trapunto, tennerriffe, hemstitching, rugs, shawls, tablecloths, just to name a few.

Post Offices-On-Wheels Gear For 'Spring Fever'

Area residents may conduct postal business outdoors this spring, Postmaster Florence Brown of the Kenansville Post Office said.

"Our rural delivery vehicles function as post offices-on-wheels," explained Brown. "As rural customers catch 'spring fever,' we'll be there to serve them."

Rural carrier services include stamp and money order sales, parcel pickup and acceptance of registered and express mail. Business transactions are completed on-the-spot at delivery stops along each route. "These 'open-air post offices' are a world apart from their city counterparts," said Brown, "yet they bring a wide range of postal services right to your door."

"Rural delivery developed a personal touch in its early days, she said, "bringing families food, newspapers, tobacco, dry goods and items that were otherwise difficult to get."

"Today, for some older residents who live in secluded areas, rural carriers serve as a lifeline to the outside world, bringing food to shut-ins during emergencies or alerting the telephone company when a storm interrupts service."

Likewise, on a clear spring day, the rural carrier's post office-on-wheels makes sure some of that personal touch remains, the postmaster said.
