Warrior	2,468 ft.	Hog Back	3,226 ft.

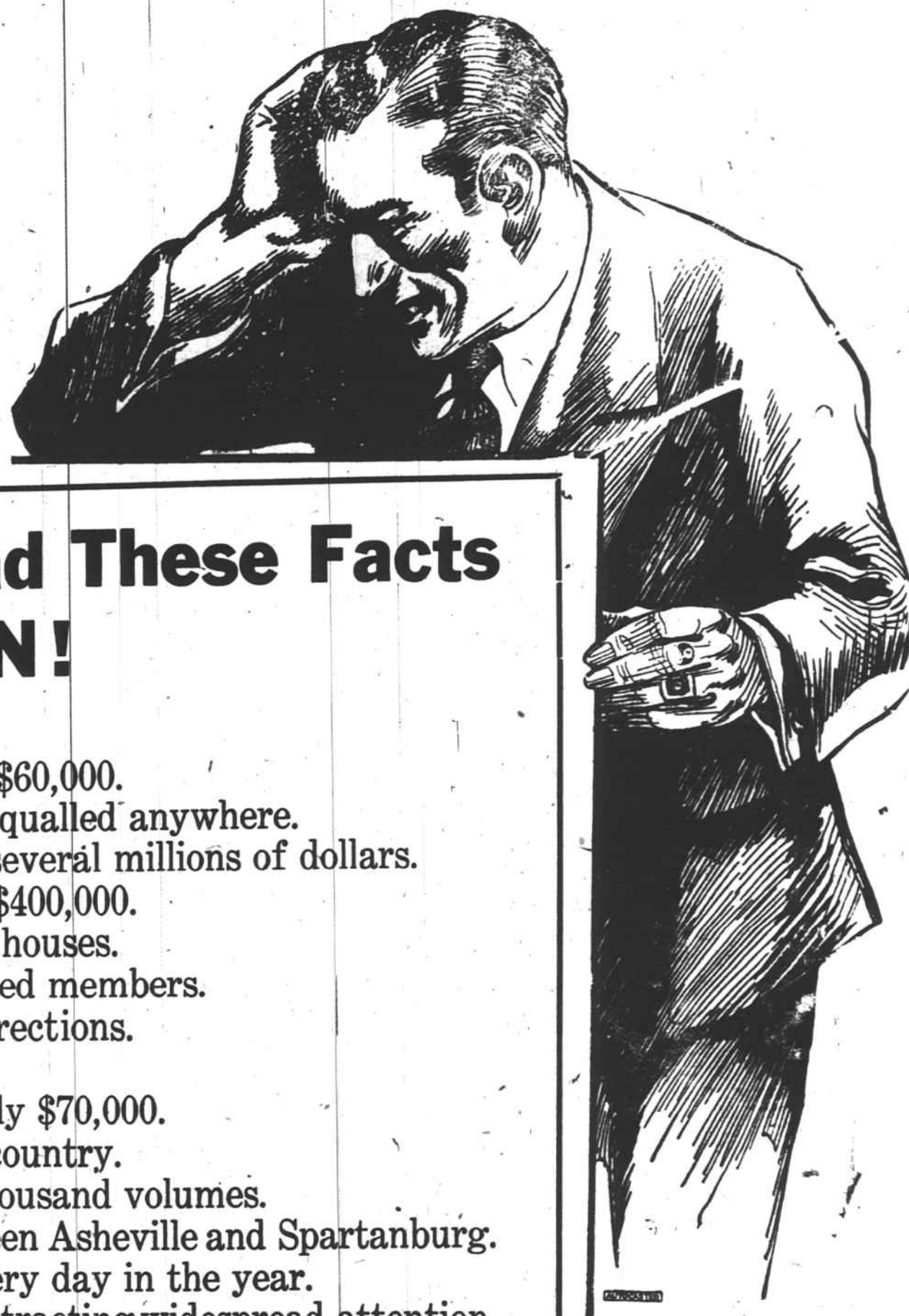
What The Tourist May See
