

Trees Need Thinning

Most trees need thinning, rather than pruning, which means cutting off many small limbs or twigs. On old, sod-bound trees, pruning often resolves itself into a matter of maintaining the balance between the feeding and fruiting parts of the tree. Some farmers do this by excessive top pruning, others do it by liberal feeding, either with nitrate in some form, or with manure. Fifteen or twenty cents' worth of nitrate will give the owner much more fruit, and better fruit, than cutting branches out of
